The meeting was opened by the President, Andrea Weinstein, at 5:30 p.m. The following items were discussed.

1. Annual/Captains' Meeting

- b. Discussion of Exhibitors:

3. Playoff Regulations with new number of teams advancing (Nancy)

- a. Nancy suggested only including the top 2 teams in the local league championships (LLC) because including the top 3 would result in too many matches
 - i. If we include the top 3 teams in our LLC we would need change the match format to pro sets and no ad scoring to fit the increased number of matches in the allotted time frame;
 - ii. It was decided that a vote on number of teams attending LLC will be taken at December board meeting.
- b. Regulations can be updated to read if 2 or more teams are invited to state, the top 2 teams will go to LLC.

4. Additional Items

- a. Nancy – registration for 2026, we need to update the tennislink fee from \$17-\$22.
- b. Nancy - State annual meeting – asking local leagues to make donation of a gift basket, Bill will send a gift basket with April to the meeting.
- c. Spring Registration:

 - iii. Schedules will be published by 1/11;
