CALL TO ORDER

1. Announcements

- a. Val & Melinda to attend September 2026 Community Development Workshop
- b. Pickle ball lines on Cane Bay Courts:
 - i. USTA Rule: Sanctioned tournaments & league play cannot be played on courts with pickle ball lines
 - ii. LCTA will not be able to play matches at Cane Bay courts
- c. Jennifer Gregg stepping down as CEO SC State, Jessica Harrell to be Interim CEO. Andrea sent congratulatory letters sent to both
- d. Bad weather impacted our May 1 & 2 Pizza TriLevel Watch Parties
- e. Doty Park:
 - i. No USTA funding.
 - ii. Summerville to fund court reconstruction and would like LCTA's help to cover costs for “extras” for approximately \$11,000.
 - iii. Andrea is working with USTA South Carolina to help fund shortage.
 - iv. Construction at Doty will not start until end of June so we will discuss later.

2. Compensation of Sandy Juzups

- a. Currently \$38 per hour in 15 minute increments, not increased in 2 years
- b. Value she brings to LCTA
